## STORAGE BURGLARIZED

Miami Police are investigating a burglary which occurred on Sunday, September 27, 2020.

According to detectives, shortly after 7:30 p.m. officers responded to a call of a burglary at 1128 N.W. 7 Avenue. Officers met with the victim/owner who reported that his storage room located in the rear of his building had been burglarized.

Video surveillance depicts an unknown black subject in the rear of the building, walking away with what appears to be a pressure cleaner. Further investigation revealed that the victim's painter machine was missing as well. The items stolen totaled approximately \$2,500.

Detectives are actively investigating this case and need assistance in identifying the subject(s) responsible.

### Detectives are looking for:

**Suspect :** Black male. Last seen wearing a white tank top with blue jean shorts.
