Subject: FATAL SHOOTING LEAVES ONE DEAD,

AND ANOTHER WOUNDED

Today, shortly before 2:00 p.m. Miami Police officers responded to 2003 North Miami Avenue regarding shots fired at the location.

According to detectives, once officers arrived on scene, they located two adult males who appeared to have been suffering from apparent gunshot wounds.

Officers immediately established a perimeter between N.W. 2nd Avenue - N.E. Miami Court between 18th - 22nd Street while S.W.A.T, K-9 and Aviation searched for a possible offender being contained within the area.

Miami Fire Rescue responded and transported both wounded individuals to Jackson Memorial Hospital where one was pronounced deceased; while the other remains in critical condition.

Detectives are still investigating leads and possible motives and ask that anyone with information to contact the Miami Police Department and/or Crime Stoppers.

There are no further updates at this time.
