Subject: **FOUR PERSONS SHOT**

Yesterday, October 23, 2020 at approximately 11:50 p.m., officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert at 1830 N.W. 50 Street reference multiple gunshots.

Once on scene, officers observed four persons suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Three wounded victims who were struck, two adult black males and a juvenile female who was grazed were immediately transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center. The fourth wounded victim, a black male in his early 20's succumbed to his injuries on the scene.

The wounded victims remain hospitalized at Jackson Memorial Hospital in stable condition.

The motive remains under investigation.

Detectives are withholding the name of the deceased victim until the next of kin is notified.

The investigation continues.
