MURDER INVESTIGATION

On Friday, October 28, 2022, at approximately 6:00 p.m., City of Miami Police officers and paramedics responded to 765 NW 36th Street in reference to a reported shooting. Upon their arriving at the crime scene, they located a homeless adult male victim, who was unresponsive and suffering from an apparent gunshot wound(s).

The victim was determined to be deceased on scene. Detectives have since identified the deceased as **Charles Herman Cole, DOB: 10/26/1954.**

Detectives need the public's help in identifying a person of interest, who was captured on nearby surveillance camera footage. The person of interest is described as a black male, possibly 19-29 years-old, 5'6" to 5'10" tall, thin build, and short dreadlocks.
