## Subject: BARRICADED ARMED SUSPECT APPREHENDED



Miami Police responded to a home located at 520 N.W. 49 Street at approximately 1:00 p.m., reference a subject who pointed a rifle at his caretaker.

Once officers arrived, a perimeter was established, and officers immediately evacuated the adjacent Adult Living Facility and the surrounding area for precautionary measures. S.W.A.T and Hostage Negotiators then established a line of communication with the armed barricaded suspect.

Members of the S.W.A.T team were able to get a visual on the barricaded subject. In order to subdue the subject, they used less than lethal ammunition. The technique was successful, and officers were able to recover the rifle from the home.

As a precaution, the suspect was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital for medical evaluation.

He is currently facing assault charges.
