Subject: **FIVE PEOPLE SHOT**

Today, June 19, 2022, officers responded to SW 22 Avenue and US1 reference an incident involving five people who were shot.

According to detectives, at approximately 2:30am, a 2005 4-door gold Nissan Altima with six occupants were shot at by the occupant(s) of another vehicle that pulled up alongside them on the northbound lanes of US1 and SW 22 Avenue. Five of the six people inside the vehicle were struck. The offending vehicle, unknown make and model, fled northbound on US1.

The driver of the Altima drove to SW 4 Avenue and 3 Street, and dropped off one of the victims, a young woman in her late teens. The driver of the vehicle proceeded to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center to seek medical attention for all the wounded victims.

The wounded young woman called 911 from the location where she was dropped off and was transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital - Ryder Trauma Center in stable condition.

At this time, all wounded victims are in stable condition are expected to make a full recovery.

The motive behind the shooting remains under investigation.
