SHOOTING INVESTIGATION

On Sunday, July 19, 2020, at approximately 2:20 p.m., Miami Police responded to a Shot Spotter alert in the area of 30 N.W. 61 Street.

According to detectives, responding police officers made contact with a male victim who stated while inside of his home, he received a phone call from his girlfriend who just arrived and was awaiting him outside. She notified him that there was an unknown male driving suspiciously up and down the street shortly before parking at the corner of the intersection. The male victim stepped outside at which point of time shot(s) were fired at him, and as a result he returned gunfire.

No one was struck nor injured at the time of the incident.

Detectives are looking for:

<u>Suspect 1</u>: Black male, approximately 19 - 20 years of age. Last seen wearing a white T-Shirt.

Offending Vehicle(s): Possibly a newer model Blue Toyota 4-Runner or Highlander.
