Subject: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On Friday, November 27, 2020, at approximately 12:30 p.m., Miami Police responded to 2 N.W. 79 Street to investigate an aggravated assault.

According to detectives, once officers arrived on scene, they made contact with a store employee who reported that an unknown subject entered the establishment and began a verbal altercation over the store's restrooms being locked. Once the subject was asked to leave he brandished a firearm and made threats to shoot the store's employee before he fled the scene.

Detectives have exhausted all leads and are requesting the community's assistance.

Suspect: Black male, slim built. Last seen wearing a gray scarf, black t-shirt with an orange and beige design on the front, long double colored jeans with white shoes.
