OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

Yesterday, at approximately **3:30 p.m.**, City of Miami Police Officers responded to a home located in the area of N.W. 5th Avenue and N.W. 56th Street reference a domestic related altercation involving a woman and a man.

According to investigators, as officers arrived on scene they were confronted by the subject who was armed with a knife. After several attempts to deescalate the situation were made, one of the officers was forced to discharge his firearm, but did not strike anyone.

The subject who has been identified as Fitzroy Haughton, D.O.B. 5/29/1997 has since been placed into police custody and charged with one count of Simple Battery and one count of Aggravated Assault on a law enforcement officer.

The City of Miami Police Department's Homicide and Internal Affairs Division continues to investigate.
