Today, Saturday, July 31st, 2021, the "Abajo Cadenas, Llamado Por La Libertad" event will take place at Bayfront Park in Downtown Miami, FL. The venue, hosted by the Bayfront Park Trust, along with City of Miami Commissioner Joe Carrollo is geared toward a cry for freedom for Cuba, Venezuela, and Nicaragua from Communist regimes. The demonstration will feature speeches from City of Miami's Mayor Francis Suarez, local radio & TV personalities, VIP's, Latin music singers, DJ performers, and musicians. Bayfront park will accommodate its open grounds for participants and attendees to express their solidarity for liberty and human rights.

Miami Police Officers were hired by the event organizers for the load-in/out set-ups, 24-hour closures, event day high visibility within the inner/outer perimeters and adjacent roads, overall area traffic/crowd control, and security purposes.

- The event will start at 5:00 PM at Bayfront Park (301 Biscayne Blvd)
- MPD personnel will be on-site as of 3PM
- 35,000 attendees, including VIP's, musicians, staff, and spectators are expected to participate.
- There are no planned street closures all manifestations will take place in the park
- In the event of a mass gathering/march takeover on Biscayne Blvd., MPD has a response plan to safely assist and alleviate all affected traffic conditions.

Miami Police personnel will be present throughout the area for high visibility/traffic and overall security purposes.
