Subject: AFTERNOON ROBBERY



On today's date at approximately 2:00 P.M. a White male victim was exiting the Flag Eagle convenience store located at 400 N.W. 7 Street. Once the victim was outside the store, an altercation between him and a Black male suspect ensued and the victim sustained serious head injuries.

Moments later, a second White male was attacked at the corner of N.W. 5 Ave. and 8 St. The second male received serious head injuries as well. The Black male suspect was then seen fleeing the area on a bike in a northern direction. Miami Fire Rescue transported both victims to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Trauma Center.

Miami Police is looking for a Black male, 20-30 years of age, 5-9-5-10, 175 pounds.
