# STUDENTS WHO PREVENTED SCHOOL SHOOTINGS HONORED BY MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT'S DO THE RIGHT THING PROGRAM

MIAMI, FL – November 10, 2021 – This month's Do The Right Thing Awards will honor 10 amazing Miami-Dade students out of over 700 nominees, who serve as an inspiration to the community and are being rewarded for doing the right thing by Miami Police. This month's winners displayed true courage and bravery as they reported a school shooting threat posted on social media, reported a student carrying a firearm on campus, and reported a student who had a "kill list"/manifesto planning to harm other students. The ceremony takes place on **Tuesday**, **November 16**, 2021 at 10:00 am in the auditorium of the Chief Clarence Dickson Police College, 350 NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.

Each month of the school year students are awarded for their positive behavior, actions, and good deeds and receive a host of prizes including a mini tablet, plaque, Do The Right Thing t-shirt and bumper sticker, two tickets to a Miami Marlins game, a free pizza from Papa John's, gift cards, and passes to area attractions such as Zoo Miami and Island Queen Cruises. The students also receive letters of congratulations from United States Senators Rick Scott and Marco Rubio as well as from Miami-Dade County Schools Superintendent Alberto Carvahlo. Two Special Recognition students are also selected and win trips to Rapids Water Park and Washington, D.C.

Do The Right Thing, Inc. is a not-for-profit, community-based program operating in cooperation with the City of Miami Police Department and other local law enforcement. The program serves school age youth throughout Miami-Dade County by recognizing positive accomplishments and behavior. Since its inception, Do The Right Thing has directly impacted over 250,000 youth in the Greater Miami area and has expanded to 68 other law enforcement agencies nationwide as well as to England and Germany. Building positive relationships between police and youth at an early age can make all the difference!
