Subject: <u>ELDERLY HANDICAPPED WOMAN SHOT IN HER HOME HOME</u>



On today's date, at approximately 11:27 A.M., an elderly black woman who is in a wheelchair was in her home watching television. An unknown Black male offender came up to her door and began shooting several shots into the house, striking the woman several times upon her body. There was a second victim injured in the home, a 26 year old Black female who is the granddaughter of the elderly victim. Investigators know that the 70 year old victim was not the intended target of the shooting.

The elderly victim was transported to Jackson Ryder Trauma unit where she is listed in serious condition. The second victim was transported by a family member to Jackson Ryder Trauma unit where she is in stable condition.

Investigators have information on who they are looking for as the offender and are checking all leads. This investigation continues.....
