Subject: FAMILY PLEA - HIT AND RUN

A family plea for <u>Juan Ruiz</u>, <u>D.O.B. 04/12/1988 (Victim) will be held on Monday, February 14, 2022</u> at <u>10:00 a.m.</u>, at The Miami Police Department's lobby located at 400 N.W. 2 Avenue, Miami, Fl, 33128.

On Sunday, January 30, 2022 at approximately 7:41 p.m., Miami Police officers responded to the area of N.W. 12 Avenue and N.W. 43 Street to investigate a call of a hit and run involving a motorcyclist with serious bodily injuries. City of Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene and transported the victim to JMH Trauma Center in serious condition where he remains today. The victim was driving a motorcycle when he was cut off by the suspect's vehicle and they collided. The suspect's vehicle never stopped.

Through investigative means, detectives believe that the vehicle which fled the scene is possibly a black Dodge Ram pick-up truck (or similar) with damage to the right rear side.

We're pleading with the community for their assistance in providing detectives with the truck's and/or suspect's information and whereabouts.
