Subject: **FAMILY PLEA – FATAL HIT AND RUN**

A family plea for **Justine Avenet, D.O.B. 02/11/1998 (Victim) will be held tomorrow, Friday November 4, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., at The Miami Police Department's lobby located at 400 N.W. 2 Avenue, Miami, Fl, 33128.**

On Sunday, October 30, 2022, at approximately 3:15 a.m., Miami Police officers responded to the area of N.E. Biscayne Boulevard & 22 Street to investigate a call of a hit and run involving a bicyclist with serious bodily injuries. City of Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene and pronounced the victim deceased on scene. The victim was driving a pedal bicycle when she was hit by the suspect's vehicle. The suspect's vehicle never stopped.

Through investigative means, detectives believe that the vehicle which fled the scene is possibly a 2018-2021, dark colored, Nissan Pathfinder (or similar) with damage to the front bumper and missing front grill and emblem.

We're pleading with the community for their assistance in providing detectives with the SUV's and/or suspect's information and whereabouts.
