Subject: FAMILY TIES ENDS IN TRAGEDY



Today, at approximately 2:10 P.M., Miami Police arrived at 1748 Northwest 30 Street, after learning from a 911 caller who stated she had frantically run from her mother's home after she went to visit her and found her unresponsive on the kitchen floor, and her brother sitting inside the living room with what appeared to be a handgun.

Miami Police's SWAT, Hostage Negotiators and K9 units arrived to assist, but once inside they realized both mother and son were unresponsive. Miami Fire Rescue pronounced both deceased.

Homicide detectives are looking closely at the circumstances that led to their death, but the facts surrounding the incident appear to be a murder suicide, where the son shot and killed the mother and later turned the gun on himself.

The mother has been identified as Concepccion Loholfftz, D.O.B.: 12-8-44 and the son has been identified as Roberto Jose Reyes, D.O.B.: 9-19-72.

The investigation continues.....
