Subject: **REPORTED CITY HALL UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY INVESTIGATION**

The City of Miami Police Department is currently investigating a reported unauthorized entry into one of our city official's office, located at Miami City Hall, 3500 Pan American Dr. The incident occurred sometime between Friday, February 24, 2023, after 4:30 p.m. and Monday, February 27, 2023, before 9:00 a.m.

At approximately 9:00 a.m. on Monday, February 27, 2023, Commissioner Manolo Reyes' desk was found with open drawers and several pictures faced down. (See the attached pictures)

Detectives will continue to investigate this case and are reviewing any surveillance footage available to identify the responsible person(s). As always, our top priority is the safety of our residents and of our city employees.

No further comment can be made as this time since it remains an open and active investigation.
