Subject: HIGH PRICED BURGLARY

Detectives are investigating a home burglary that occurred at approximately 3:15 a.m. on October 26, 2020 in the area of the 4100 block of N.W. 10 Avenue.

On October 26, 2020 the victim was away from home when he received a RING Doorbell notification at approximately 3:18 a.m. The victim could see that there were masked persons on his property. The victim rushed home and when he arrived he saw that his rear door was breached and left open. He proceeded inside and noticed that the house was ransacked. The victim's three French Bulldogs were gone. A fourth dog was left in the house and appeared injured. Also stolen were nine (9) firearms, twenty (20) flash bangs, and miscellaneous designer clothes.

In total over \$7,500 in firearms, \$20,000 in clothing, and three (3) French Bulldogs worth \$60,000 were all stolen.

Detectives are working the case and need assistance in identifying the suspects, recovering the dogs, and locating the stolen firearms.

Suspects: 3 Males wearing hoodies and masks at the time of the burglary.
