Subject: POLICE VEHICLE TAKEN AND CRASHED  
DURING INVESTIGATION

On today, October 30, 2015, at approximately 10:47 A.M., Miami Police were dispatched to 841 Northwest 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue in reference to a female running in and out of traffic. Upon officers arriving, the female subject fled down the street, and climbed on top of the roof of one of the homes in the area. As the officer approached the subject, attempting to get her off the roof, she jumped off, and into the officer's marked police vehicle and fled south on Northwest 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

The officer's back up unit was approaching the area to assist him in apprehending the subject, when she crashed the police vehicle into the back up officer's vehicle, causing major damage. The subject then jumped out of the police vehicle and fled westbound to Northwest 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue where she was apprehended and taken into custody.

Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene, and transported the injured officer and the female subject to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center. The officer was treated and released. The other officer involved was treated on the scene.
