BOUNCE BACK FROM CANCER 2026

The Bounce Back from Cancer – Dribble and Walk event will take place on Saturday, March 14, 2026. The 14-mile total walk will begin at 6:00 AM from the Miami Cancer Institute (8900 N. Kendall Drive). An expected 750 participants are expected to enter the City of Miami at approximately 8:00 AM, traveling through the neighborhood areas of Coconut Grove, Brickell, and Downtown Miami. There will be additional starting walks along the course of a 6-mile course: Regatta Park and 2-mile course: The Underline (Brickell).

COURSE

Start: Miami Cancer Institute (8900 N. Kendall Drive) at 6:00 AM

- Eastbound from Kendall
- North through Ingraham Park
- Merge into Coconut Grove corridor
- Continue north along Bayshore Drive towards Brickell

6-Mile Route-Start: Regatta Park (Pan American Drive) at 10:00 AM

- Merge onto S. Bayshore Drive
- Enter Brickell via SE 32nd Road
- Northbound on Brickell Avenue
- Transition west/east through SE 13th Street, S. Miami Avenue, SW 9th Street
- Move north toward Downtown via SW 1st Avenue

2-Mile Route-Start: The Underline (SW 1st Avenue) at 11:30 AM

- Northbound through Brickell
- Cross S. Miami Avenue Bridge
- Enter Downtown via SE 4th Street and SE 1st Avenue
- Proceed north on Biscayne Boulevard toward NE 8th Street

All routes finish at Kaseya Center 601 Biscayne Boulevard with an estimated finish time of 12:30 PM.

Intermittent traffic control and detours will start in our jurisdiction at 8:00 AM until approximately 12:30 PM.

Miami Police and outside agency personnel will be positioned throughout the course and closure areas to assist with pedestrian and vehicular traffic and ensure a safe event environment.
