COLD CASE HOMICIDE ARREST

On February 5, 2021, at approximately 10:27 a.m., Miami Police received a ShotSpotter alert of several rounds fired in the area of 1535 NW 58 Street. Officers were dispatched and upon arrival, they located the victim (Tilkharri Harris) in the driver's seat of a Mercedes Benz. Mr Harris had been shot multiple times. Miami Fire Rescue transported the victim to JMH Trauma where he was pronounced deceased.

Detectives were able to obtain video and other evidence of the vehicle the shooter was using, and a BOLO was issued. Miami Dade PD officers contacted our Homicide Unit and gave us information about the Black Chevrolet Blazer we were looking for.

Throughout the relentless efforts, dedication, and evidence obtained by the Homicide Detectives, they were able to identify Terrance Martin as the shooter.

Detectives pieced the case together and charged Terrance Martin with Murder Second-Degree, Murder First-Degree with Deadly Weapon, Shooting a Deadly Missile, and Firearm/Ammunition Possession by a Convicted Felon. Martin was already in jail for an unrelated case.

I would like to thank the men and women of the Miami Police Department that were directly involved with this case and bringing justice to the victim and his family. Chief Manuel Morales
