NEW CHARGES FILED IN ONGOING SEXUAL ABUSE INVESTIGATION

The Special Victims Unit (SVU) of the Miami Police Department is actively investigating crimes against children involving Osher Pittman and has identified an additional victim.

On August 18, 2025, a search warrant was executed at Pittman's residence, where multiple images of minors were discovered on his cell phone. Detectives have been working diligently to identify all the children depicted in these photos and have successfully located and identified one of the children.

Pittman is currently incarcerated for previous offenses; however, a new Arrest Affidavit has been filed, introducing six additional charges.
