## SUBJECT ARRESTED ON 19 CASES OF CRIMINAL MISCHIEF

Miami Police Burglary detectives have arrested 69-year-old Patrick Hennessy for a string of vandalisms (19) dated from February 2, 2024 to present. Detectives first became aware of a subject carving the letters LLX onto vehicles in the areas of Downtown, Little Havana, and Brickell neighborhoods.

Hennessy used the same MO (modus operandi) on all reported cases. He would approach unoccupied vehicles and would use a tool to carve the letters LLX onto the doors of the vehicles. He would do it deep enough to penetrate through all layers of paint and leave the bare metal of the vehicle exposed. In total, nineteen (19) victims reported the vandalism. The damage caused is over \$19,000 of repair cost.

Through investigative means and great teamwork between detectives and patrol officers, we were able to identify and arrest Patrick Hennessy for the 19 cases.

Detectives believe that there could be additional victims who might have been targeted and did not report it. If there are any additional victims who have not reported it, we urge you to file a report with the City of Miami PD, 305-579-6111.
