As the festival attracts thousands of attendees, significant road closures will be in effect to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for festival-goers and residents.

Street Closures:

RELEASI

Saturday, March 8, 2025:

- 6:00 p.m.: SW 22nd Avenue will be closed between SW 7th Street and SW 8th Street.
- 9:00 p.m.: Eastbound traffic on SW 8th Street (from SW 27th Avenue to SW 13th Avenue) will be closed.
- All roads will reopen by 5:00 a.m. on Monday, March 10, 2025.

Detours and Traffic Impact:

- Eastbound traffic on SW 8th Street will be detoured northbound or southbound at SW 27th Avenue. Alternate routes include SW 1st Street, SW 10th Street, or Coral Way.
- Westbound traffic on SW 7th Street will be detoured northbound or southbound at SW 12th Avenue. Alternate routes include SW 6th Street, West Flagler Street, or Coral Way.

Residents living in the affected areas will have local traffic access only to SW 7th Street (north side) or SW 9th Street (south side). Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and use alternate routes to avoid delays in the area.

Miami Police Officers and personnel will be stationed along the route to assist with traffic flow and provide guidance as necessary.
