Subject: **ARREST MADE IN ATTEMPTED MURDER CASE**

On December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 2:18 a.m. Miami Police received a ShotSpotter Alert of several rounds fired at 5950 NE Biscayne Boulevard. Upon officers arriving, they located a male victim suffering from several gunshot wounds. Miami Fire Rescue promptly responded and transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital Ryder Trauma. Detectives immediately began their investigation and located a witness as well as video surveillance. Through the investigation detectives spoke with the witness who shared information of the suspect later identified as 29-year-old K'Andre Malyk Dorival.

On the video surveillance, the victim is seen walking up to a white, 4-door, Toyota Camry's driver's side window. The victim is seen having a conversation with the driver of the vehicle. A short time later, shots are fired from the driver of the vehicle striking the victim as he collapsed. Through investigative means, detectives identified the vehicle owner and created a photo line-up. The witness positively identified a picture of K'Andre Malyk Dorival as the suspect.

On January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 1:10 p.m. the Miami Police Gun Intelligence Detail located and arrested K'Andre Malyk Dorival and transported him to Miami Police Violent Crimes Unit where he was interviewed. Dorival was charged with Attempted 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder and Displaying a Firearm While Committing a Felony. He was subsequently transported to TKG.

Once again, this shows the commitment and dedication of the City of Miami Police Department Detectives to identify and capture anyone committing a violent crime in the City of Miami.
