HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

On February 16, 2026, at approximately 6:45 p.m., Miami Police officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert reporting multiple gunshots near NW 13th Avenue and 51st Street. Upon arrival, officers located a 19-year-old male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Miami Fire Rescue personnel rendered immediate assistance and transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Trauma Center, where he was later pronounced deceased. The deceased has been identified as **Qumourie Gay**.

In a related incident, officers located a second male (18-years-old) with a gunshot wound to the leg at NW 12 Avenue and 50 Street. He was treated by Miami Fire Rescue Service and subsequently transported to JMH Trauma.

As the investigation progressed, we received reports of a third male (18-years-old) who had also sustained a leg injury from the gunfire, left the scene, and was at a different location. Miami Police and Miami Fire Rescue Service responded swiftly, providing treatment and transporting him to JMH Trauma.

Homicide Detectives are actively investigating this tragic incident and are urging anyone with information or video to come forward.
